In July 2007, the Governor signed the Smoke-free Illinois Act into law, making Illinois the 22nd state to be smoke-free. The Act, which took effect on January 1, 2008, prohibits smoking in public places, places of employment and government vehicles. It also prohibits smoking within fifteen (15) feet of any entrance to a public place or place of employment. **This form is for complaints within suburban Cook County municipalities only.****
