## Become a recognized Healthy HotSpot

To be recognized as a tobacco/smoke-free park district, the park district policy must explicitly outline the tobacco/smoke-free protections in place. Submit your request for recognition by completing the form below and sending a copy of your policy for verification. Please email documents to [healthyhotspot@cookcountyhhs.org](mailto:healthyhotspot@cookcountyhhs.org) and allow 6-8 weeks for review and processing.

Recognized tobacco/smoke-free parks, along with park district contact information, will be listed on the Healthy HotSpot map. There are two recognition levels for tobacco/smoke-free park districts:

### **GOLD:**

- Tobacco-Free - Park district policy prohibits use of all tobacco products (chewing tobacco, dip, snus, snuff, etc.) anywhere on park district property during both public and private use.

### **SILVER:**

- Smoke-Free - Park district policy prohibits smoking cigarettes, cigars, cigarillos, and other combustible products anywhere on park district property during both public and private use.
